THANK YOU TO ALL OF OUR WONDERFUL VOLUNTEERS

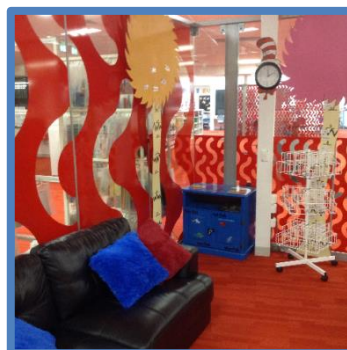
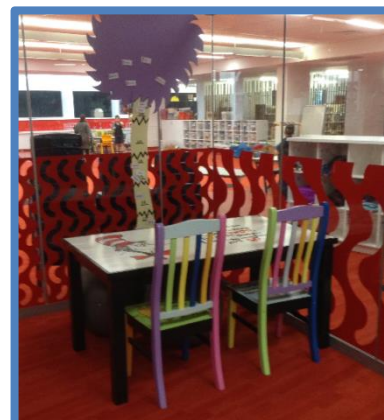
