HAND, FOOT and MOUTH DISEASE

There has been a report of Hand, Foot and Mouth in our school. This is a viral infection. Symptoms include a slight fever, tiredness, loss of appetite, blisters in the mouth, hands and feet and a sore mouth for a few days before the ulcers or blisters appear. Affected young children may refuse to eat or drink. Spread takes place through contact with the fluid in the blisters.

Infectious period: As long as there is fluid in the blisters. Exclusion from school: until all blisters have dried.

MORPHETT VALE INDOOR CRICKET



Morphett Vale Primary School are calling for all Parents &/or Family Members who can spare some time to assist our children with beginning an Out of Hours Indoor Cricket Sport team/s which will be run in Terms 4 2018 & Term 1 2019. As it stands, we have one interested coach and team manager and a lot of interested kids.

Dependant on numbers, a guide to approximate nights will be either

Wednesday or Thursday evenings with games starting at 4pm, 4.30pm and 5 to 5.15pm. A game generally takes 75 minutes maximum, with most junior games taking an hour. To participate, students pay \$7 per game plus \$10 registration per term (per player) as a one off fee. They also offer two free training sessions at the ICA, which can be held towards the end of this term, where ICA staff will train teams in the rules that apply to indoor cricket and it allows them to have a go in the indoor environment prior to game nights.

The Morphett Vale Action Indoor Sports Centre supply the umpire, scorer, bats, balls, and the only equipment needed to be purchased by parents is an abdominal protector, which is sold at the centre for \$6. No helmets or shin pads are required due to softer ball being used and differences with game rules.

It would be fantastic if parents could assist, even if you know very little about the sport.
