## CONGRATULATION MORPHETT VALE PRIMARY

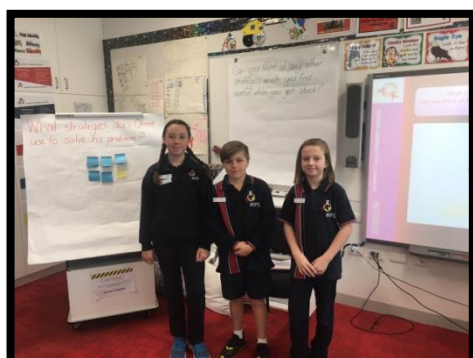

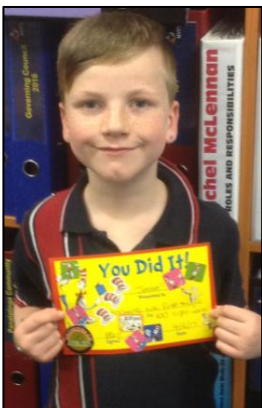
## LOST AND FOUND

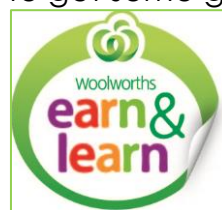
## Woolworths Earn & Learn 2017
