

The Smith Family

Scholarship (Financial assistance)

The Smith Family *Learning for Life* education scholarships give families and students the opportunity to access everyday needs for education by reducing financial difficulty and supporting the whole family to achieve. A Payment of \$450 (over 2 payments) is received to go towards educational costs.

Requirements

1. *At least one primary carer has a current pension, concession or health care card*
2. *Demonstrate a strong commitment to education through 90% school attendance.*
3. *Child attends a Smith Family Partner School*

Learning Clubs

Learning clubs provide homework and curriculum content assistance out-of-school in a safe and supportive environment. Both primary and secondary students are welcome to attend once or twice a week at no cost, which are run for a minimum of 2 terms.

Student2student

Student2student (s2s) improves reading skills of students aged 8 to 13 years. Students who are up to two years behind in their reading are paired with trained buddies who contact them over the phone after school and support them in order to improve their reading skills.

University Experience Days & Straighttalks

Students are able to attend a day at University, allowing them to gain a positive outlook and explore a wide-range of opportunities. Straighttalks are in-school, career pathway presentations from a range of guest speakers.

TechPros

TechPros is a 'digital basics' program, that supports students in Upper Primary to develop and improve their foundational digital literacy skills.

Young ICT Explorers & Kidpreneur

Young ICT Explorers is a competition to encourage school students in years 3 to 12 to create a technology-based project of their choice. Kidpreneur is an immersive experiential entrepreneurship program recommended for years 5 and 6. Students build their own micro-business, creating, making, pitching & selling their own products or services.

Future Seekers

The Future Seekers program aims to increase students understanding of how their strengths and interests relate to the world of work, so that they increase their self-belief in achieving a career aspiration and be more engaged at school.

Certificate 1 Financial Services (Financial Literacy)

The Certificate 1 Financial Services assists young people in developing skills to better manage their finances whilst providing further knowledge to therefore make well-informed financial decisions.

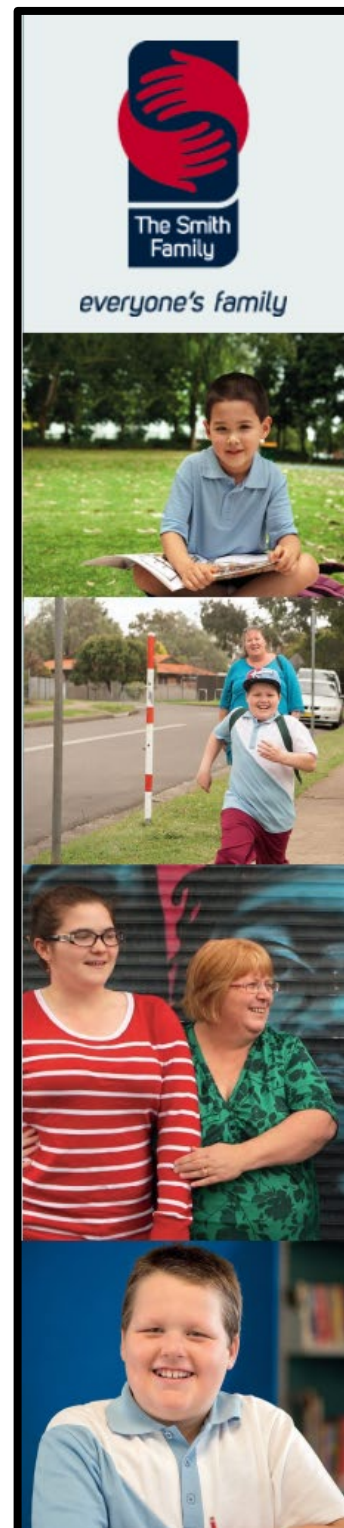
