This term sees our staff mentor preservice teachers across various grades. We welcome:

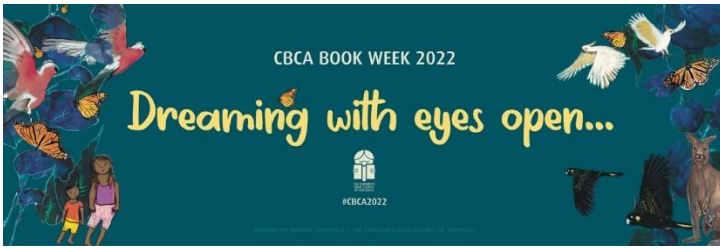

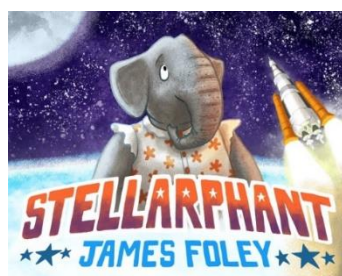
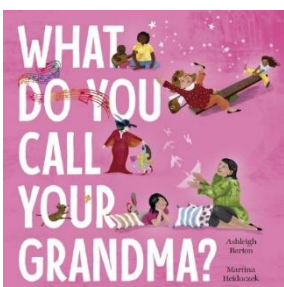
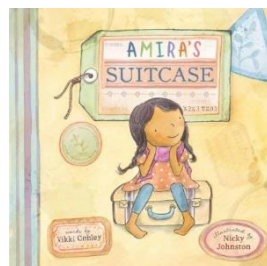
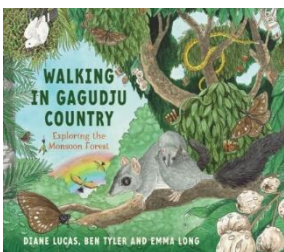
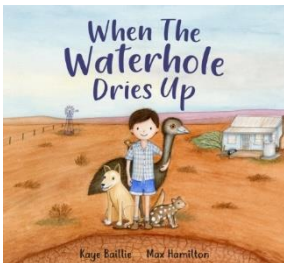



## Dreaming With Eyes Open...
