Finance News

Dear Families,

We hope you are doing well! We want to update you on a few important items regarding the Materials & Services (M&S) charges for 2024.

Invoice and Rebate Information: You might have noticed two invoices for the M&S charges in your recent emails, along with a credit note for a \$100 rebate. Don't worry, this was just a duplicate email, and your account has not been charged twice. The \$100 is a special rebate provided by the SA Government for 2024, and it's applied directly to your M&S fees.

School Card Information: For families who qualify for the school card, there's no need to take any action regarding these emails. Remember, the school card application needs to be renewed annually. You can apply online at www.sa.gov.au/education/schoolcard, or pick up a paper application from our front office. If you're not sure about your eligibility, please check the income limit table we've attached.

M&S Fee Details: For those paying the full M&S fees, please note that the total amount per student, after deducting the rebate, is \$187, not \$287.

Payment Options: You can choose to pay via cash, EFTPOS (either in person or over the phone), direct deposit (please include your family name and number as a reference), or through the Qkr app.

Special Events Levy: We've changed how we handle the Special Events levy (which covers activities like incursions and excursions). Instead of a separate invoice, these costs will now be billed individually for each event. Please ensure payment is made before the due date for your child to participate.

Upcoming Statements: Please look out for upcoming statements that will detail any other overdue fees.
